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## Common Criteria update

- The new Protection Profile for Hardcopy Devices (PP\_HCD\_V1.0) was published on September 11.

- It is a US/Japan PP, not a "cPP" with broader international support.

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### Common Criteria meetings

- Two MFP TC meetings were held at the CCUF-CCDB Workshops.
- Meeting 1 (18 September)
  - This was a brief, stand-up meeting to confirm discussions that had previously taken place between the US, JP, and KR schemes.
  - The general agreement is to work with the new HCD PP for the next six to twelve months and consider if a revision of that PP could accommodate KR issues, or if an iTC should be formed to write an HCD cPP.
- Meeting 2 (21 September)
  - We had a wide-ranging discussion on a variety of topics. For details:

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### Common Criteria plans

- There are no plans to create an iTC to develop a cPP.
   It will be reconsidered in six to twelve months.
- There may be some effort to add cryptographic algorithms and different assurance requirements (primarily for Korea).
- Any significant changes would be published as a new version, e.g. V1.1.

- NIAP plans to issue a document stating that FIPS validation can be used to satisfy the CC certification requirement for SEDs until FDE cPP v2.0 is published.
- NIAP has not yet set up a TRRT for the HCD PP.
