<b>jmJobName</b> - Job name (assigned by job owner) which is not necessarily unique.	-	
<b>jmJobIdName</b> - the job's identifier name generated by the job submitting software using the job submission protocol. This name can be anything that helps identifier the job to the job submitter, including the name of the queue from which the job was submitted.	-	
<b>jmJobIdNumber</b> - the job's identifier number generated by the job submitting software using the job submission protocol. A (-2) value shall indicate that the submitter did not supply a job identifier number.	- Connection Identifier	PAP parameter included in the ATP layer
<b>jmJobOwner</b> - Job owner (User name of the user that originally submitted the job)	- %%Creator: <i>name</i> - and / or - %%For: <i>name</i>	PostScript comments - Application dependent - Format not consistent - Creator is normally application or driver program name
<b>jmJobDeviceNameRequested</b> - Device name (or queue name) requested by the submitting user.	-
