A brief discussion at the Denver meeting made it clear that opinions vary as to the legitimate combinations of *resp*, *sbp_status*, *status* and *residual* within an SBP-2 status block that corresponds to a PPDT transport flow or control ORB. I took an action item to prepare a summary of my personal opinions; the results are intended as the starting point of a continued discussion in Raleigh.

Note that a negative value for *residual* may be reported only when the connection was established in datagram mode. In stream mode, the target transfers whatever data it can to the initiator or, in the other direction, waits until it has buffer space to accept all the initiator s data.
