20 **1.1 Conformance Terminology**

- 21 Capitalized terms, such as MUST, MUST NOT, RECOMMENDED, REQUIRED, SHOULD,
- 22 SHOULD NOT, MAY, and OPTIONAL, have special meaning relating to conformance as
- 23 defined in Key words for use in RFCs to Indicate Requirement Levels [BCP14].

24 **1.2 Other Terminology**

- 25 PWG Voting Member: A PWG Member who has a current membership that includes voting
- 26 rights and that has paid their current membership dues. [PWG_PROCESS]

- 30 There are several levels of PWG Membership, each with their own voting rights and dues
- 31 schedule. PWG Members with voting rights are referred to here and in PWG Process

- 33 Levels and their associated annual dues and entitlements.
- 34 PWG Members pay dues annually.
