General Discussion

- ❖ Minutes from the previous teleconference were accepted (see <ftp://ftp.pwg.org/pub/pwg/ipp/ippv2-minutes/IPPV2-ConCall-Minutes-20080602.doc>).
- ❖ Reviewed updated table of IPP operations for v2.x (see <ftp://ftp.pwg.org/pub/pwg/ipp/ippv2-docs/IPPV2-OPS-REQUIRED-2008-06-13.pdf>)
 - Ron reviewed the rules including a process for overriding decisions
 - Final consensus listed as “R” (required) or “O” (optional)
 - Novell’s feedback was incorporated as part of the discussion
 - See Ron’s updated document (forthcoming)
 - 2.x requires valid responses on the wire even if operation not supported
 - All 2.0 operations “optional”. Sweet suggested 2.0 include all required operation in 1.1 with media definitions incorporated.
 - Operations marked with O* will need more discussion in the face-to-face meeting
 - Reprocess job may not be such a great idea. More discussion is desirable.
 - Specification is expected to be short.

- Challenge may be in interoperability testing using profiles for 2.0, 2.1, and 2.2.
 - Can we get the Steering Committee to waive the interoperability requirement if there are existing implementations (not new protocol required)?
