IETF IPP/1.1 Updates

- Developing two new RFCs to replace (obsolete) RFCs 2910, 2911, 3381 (deprecated job progress attributes), and 3382 (collection attribute syntax)
- Stable drafts:
 - <http://tools.ietf.org/html/draft-sweet-rfc2910bis>
 - <http://tools.ietf.org/html/draft-sweet-rfc2911bis>
 - *RFC2910bis is approved and waiting for RFC2911bis for publication*
 - *RFC2911bis is going through a second IETF Last Call to address some "down references" to informational documents.*
 - *RFCs will eventually be advanced to IETF Internet Standard through status change (IETF process)*

- Alternate vendor prefix for keyword names

Alternate Vendor Prefix for Keyword Names



- Currently RFC 2911bis says to use reverse-DNS prefix on keyword names ('com.example-foo') unless the keyword defines another policy
- During the IPP WG conference call on July 25, 2016, an alternate (shorter) prefix was suggested using SMI Enterprise Numbers
 - <https://www.iana.org/assignments/enterprise-numbers/enterprise-numbers>
- Examples:
 - Hewlett-Packard (11): 'smi11-foo'
 - Apple (63): 'smi63-bar'
- SMI Enterprise Numbers are free to get and are widely used in other standards (TCG, etc.)
 - Also assigned for applications, organizations, etc.
- Prefix is obviously shorter than the reverse-DNS one
- Thoughts?

IPP Everywhere Self-Certification

- Working on 1.0 tools update that addresses known issues
 - Targeting end of September 2016 for PWG Call for Objections
- Future 1.1 errata update for manual and tools in 2017
 - More tests (Cancel-My-Jobs, Close-Job, Identify-Printer)
 - Other necessary changes that are not simple bug fixes in the tools/submission portal

Prototype Experience (Apple)

- Apple has implemented a portion of the IPP 3D Printing Extensions - the current work-in-progress is available at:
 - <https://github.com/istopwg/ippsample>
 - The "examples" directory contains sample 3MF files from the 3MF Consortium's Github samples repository, along with an ipptool test file (create-job-3d.test) that can be used to test a prototype.
- THIS PROTOTYPE IS INCOMPLETE
- Issues addressed by updated prototype draft:
 - Conformance requirements for the new attributes/member attributes.
 - "materials-col-database" RECOMMENDED, "materials-col" + "materials-col-ready" REQUIRED
 - "print-rafts" and "print-supports" should be RECOMMENDED
 - 'ipp-3d' should be REQUIRED in "ipp-features-supported"
 - Add tables for IPP attributes that are required for IPP 3D, a la IPP Everywhere
 - "print-accuracy" now has an "accuracy-units" member attribute for explicit units
 - "material-diameter" is now nanometers, to match "material-shell-thickness"
 - The section on materials-col-database now talks about the contents of each collection, i.e. type and temperature range, diameter, rate, etc., omit member attributes that can take any of the xxx-supported values, etc.


