
- Locale is scoped out should be looked at by the group
 - Sets the stage for User interface definition and Localization
- What we should concentrate on next
 - The list contains related items it's difficult to not work on some of the items together



- For example: Media
 - UPDF has a Media tag. However it really is in the UI and has to have corresponding command to select the media type. Also the displayed list is usually localized.
- Paper handling, UI, and Localization are logically grouped together.
- Constraints and Installable Options are tied to the UI and should be next.

- Resources are related to Localization
- PDL order is related to Paper handling





- Current document is the start of a mapping document from the Color LaserJet 4500.
- All required PPD keywords are listed.
- Most but not all PPD keywords are represented with a UPDF XML tag or an attribute.

We can add matching XML tags if we feel that the keywords are generic enough. Or we can add a CustomTag that will allow for the PPD keywords and additional vendor specific keywords.
